#### SUPPORTING SOMALILAND'S FUTURE

For Somaliland, the growing trade ecosystem in Berbera is a cornerstone of the economy and by 2035 is expected to facilitate trade equivalent to nearly 27% of GDP and 75% of total trade, indirectly supporting 53,000 jobs in the country. DP World have also partnered with the Berbera Electric Company (BEC) to power the port through solar energy.
