DP WORLD CAUCEDO – DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

DP World began operations in the Dominican Republic in 2003 with its port facility located on the Punta Caucedo peninsula. The country was selected for its prime geographical location, which positions it as a vital transit point between North, South, and Central America, and as a gateway for shipping routes across the Caribbean.

Together with DP World, the Dominican government wants Punta Caucedo to become the logistics hub of the Americas.

DP World Caucedo is a world-class Logistics Hub and free trade zone. Located near the city of Santo Domingo and enabled by its free zone integration, Caucedo is the newest and most modern port on the island, and a gateway for the Caribbean food trade.



INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT

Since commencing operations in 2003, DP World has invested close to \$715 million in Caucedo, from port berth expansion to additional super Post-Panamax crane and rubber tyre gantry cranes to a new air cargo logistics hub in Punta Cana. Since 2020, the operational capacity of DP World Caucedo has doubled from 1.2 million to 2.5 million.



FACILITATING THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF MAJOR GOODS

DP World's Caucedo Multimodal port is used for importing containerised and loose cargo ships. Its four berths are involved in the import of bulk fertilisers and wheat, as well as the export of cement, clinker, sugar, molasses, and bagged fertilisers.

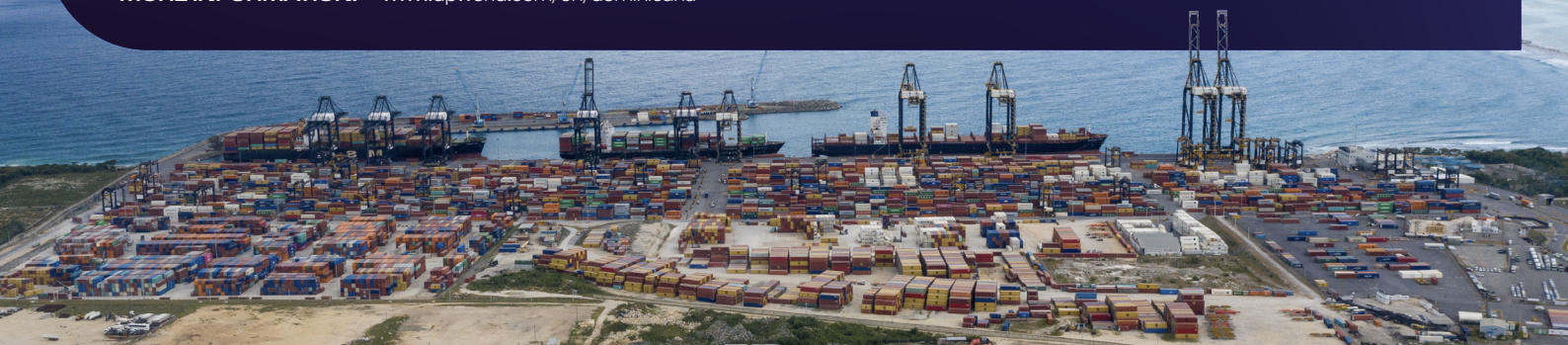

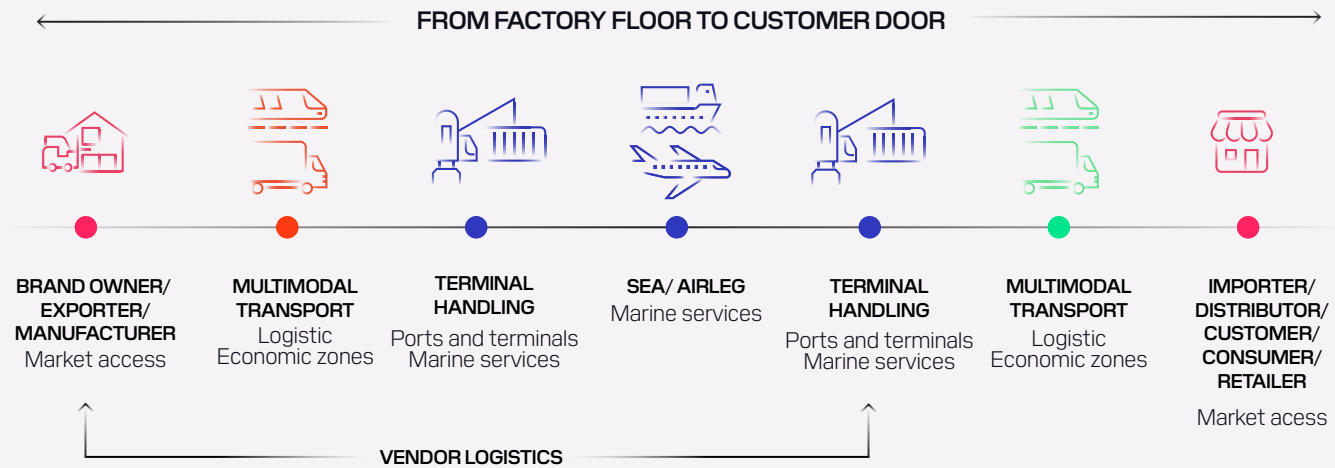
