DP World has a unique range of supply chain services to serve humanitarian aid organisations. DP World Logistics is present in more than 120 locations worldwide and offers freight forwarding and warehousing services, including pharmaceutical grade facilities. Our network of more than 60 ports and terminals provides access to aid destinations along strategic corridors and our marine services division provides container transportation along strategic routes with a fleet of 43 container vessels. Our Market Access division provides more than \$130 million worth of health and other relief goods to aid organisations every year. We provide life-saving relief for those in need, when and where it matters most.

AGILITY IN CRISIS SITUATIONS:

- In response to increasing humanitarian needs in **Sudan**, DP World has moved critical shipments out of Dubai by ocean freight and road freight through to the DP World terminal in Jeddah and from Jeddah across to Port Sudan using one of the 43 vessels in our fleet.
- In response to increasing humanitarian needs in **Gaza**, DP World has moved urgent shipments using a DP World vessel sailing out of DP World port Jebel Ali, Dubai to the DP World port of Sokhna, Egypt and onward to Al Arish by road. The DP World port of Limassol has also been used as a critical transit hub for urgent food aid to Gaza.
- With increased difficulty accessing airports and seaports in **Lebanon**, DP World arranged for deliveries of critical medical items into Beirut from Dubai by road freight.

SUSTAINABILITY IS ALWAYS A PRIORITY:

DP World is committed to reduce scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas emissions by 42% by 2030 from a 2022 base year. We are further committed to reduce absolute scope 3 greenhouse gas emissions by 28% within the same timeframe. Our targets have been validated by the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi).
