

PRIVACY POLICY REGARDING PRIOR REGISTRATION OF VISITORS

If you wish to visit (one of) the business premises (terminals) of the companies of the DP World group (hereinafter: 'DP World') at the port of Antwerp, you need to sign up in advance by providing your first- and last name as well as your date of birth. When you actually come and visit the business premises, you will most likely also be filmed.

The processing of your personal data is based upon article 5 c) (necessary to comply with a legal obligation) and/or f) (legitimate interests) of the Act of 8 December 1992 on the protection of privacy in relation to the processing of personal data and article 6.1. c) (necessary to comply with a legal obligation) and/or f) (legitimate interests) of the General Data Protection Regulation (Regulation 2016/679).

The personal data shall be processed for the purposes of general safety, security and access control and in order to enable DP World to comply with its obligations under the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS) and European Regulation n°725/2004. To the extent this would be necessary to carry-out the aforementioned purposes, the personal data may be shared with certain recipients (e.g. IT service providers for software related to access control, etc.). These recipients will take the necessary technical and organisational measures in order to protect the personal data.

If this is legally justified or required, the personal data may also be transferred to competent governments and/or other law enforcement authorities (e.g. police, investigating judge, Commission for the Protection of Privacy / Data Protection Authority, etc.).

You are entitled to access your personal data and have them corrected when inaccurate or incomplete, to have them erased and to object the processing or have their processing restricted, when the legal conditions thereto are met.

You are entitled to obtain a copy of your personal data (in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format) and to have the personal data transferred to another controller (right to data portability).

The personal data will be retained by DP World as long as required by law.

You are entitled to file a complaint with the Belgian national data protection authority (Gegevenbeschermingsautoriteit / l'Autorité de protection des données - Rue de la Presse, 35, 1000 Brussel - commission@privacycommission.be).
