



## WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF



### EMERGENCY/FIRE

Call security at T. +32 3 730 49 49.  
They will contact the emergency services.



### NBC-ALARM

In case of a nuclear, biological or chemical alarm, report to the nearest building or vehicle.  
Close windows and doors and turn off ventilation and air conditioning. Await further instructions.



### ACCIDENTS

Call medical assistance at T. +32 3 541 00 23.  
Within the Port of Antwerp, there is central medical assistance via S.I.W.H.A.



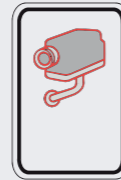
### EVACUATION

# SAFETY RULES

## IN GENERAL

Everyone on our terminal, including visitors, suppliers and contractors, must follow the safety and security rules.



Pedestrians and (motorized) bicycles are prohibited on the terminal



Always use a flashing light or the four direction indicators



Seat belt use is mandatory

## PPE MANDATORY
