

## PRIVACY POLICY E-MAIL SIGNATURE

By sending us an e-mail you provide us certain personal data and you consent that we, DP World Antwerp Holding NV, with registered address at Molenweg (KAL), Haven 1950, 9130 Beveren and registered at the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises with number BE0406.070.605, shall process these personal data in the context of the e-mail you sent. It primarily concerns the following personal data: your full name, e-mail address, telephone number and profession (function). DP World Antwerp Holding NV processes your personal data as data controller as defined by Regulation (EU) 2016/679, known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The processing of personal data is based on article 6.1. a) consent, 6.1. b) necessary for the performance of a contract, 6.1. c) compliance with a legal obligation or 6.1. f) legitimate interests – processing with a view of a smooth and efficient day-to-day carrying out of our activities of the GDPR. To the extent that the processing is based upon consent, you can withdraw your consent at any time.

Depending on our relationship your personal data might be processed for several purposes, nevertheless this will most likely constitute client- or supplier administration, the performance of an agreement between us and you (or your employer) or the performance of our day-to-day business activities. If you consent thereto, we will also use your personal data to send commercial communications (direct marketing).

To the extent required to carry out the aforementioned purposes, we may share your personal data with other companies within the DP World group. To the extent necessary in the context of our (contractual) relationship, we can also share your personal data with some of our partners. We will ensure that these recipients undertake to process your personal data in compliance with the applicable legislation. If these recipients process your personal data outside the European Economic Area we will use our best efforts to conclude the necessary (contractual) safeguards in this regard (e.g. EC Standard Clauses or similar contractual safeguards) in order for your personal data to have an adequate level of protection.

You are at all times entitled to access your personal data and have them corrected when inaccurate or incomplete, to have them erased and to have the processing thereof restricted, when the legal conditions hereto are met. In as far as the processing is based on your consent, you may withdraw your consent at all times. Please note however that we, and as the case may be, other companies of the DP World group and/or our partners, may not be able to comply with our/their contractual obligations in such case. We do not accept any liability in this regard.



You have the right to request a copy of your personal data as well as the right to data portability and the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.
