

PRIVACY POLICY TRUCK DRIVERS

By entering the business premises of DP World Antwerp you consent that we, DP World Antwerp Holding NV, with registered address at Molenweg (KAL), Haven 1950, 9130 Beveren, Belgium and registered at the Crossroads Bank of Enterprises under number BE0406.070.605., shall process your personal data in the context of the activities you will perform on DP World Antwerp's premises. We collect these personal data both directly from you or through other channels (for example Neo-platform to perform a safety test or Alfapass). It will primarily concern the following personal data: your full name, date of birth, ID number, gender, telephone number, e-mail address, profession (function), number plate, nationality and test results of the Neo-platform. DP World Antwerp Holding NV processes your personal data as data controller as defined by Regulation (EU) 2016/679, known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

The processing of personal data is based on article 6.1. a) consent, 6.1. b) necessary for the performance of a contract, 6.1. c) compliance with a legal obligation or 6.1. f) legitimate interests of the GDPR. To the extent that the processing is based upon consent, you can withdraw your consent at any time.

The personal data are processed for administrative purposes, to provide you access to the business premises and to make sure DP World complies with legal obligations following the International Ship and Port Facility Security Code (ISPS) and European Regulation n° 725/2004 and for reasons of general safety (e.g. speed limit controls) and security (certified pick up of containers ("Certified Pick Up") in the sense of the General Port Police Regulations applicable in the port area of Antwerp, NIS Directives, Decree of 02.03.1999 relating to management of seaports (Port Decree) etc.

To the extent required to carry out the aforementioned purposes, we may share your personal data with other companies within the DP World group. To the extent necessary in the context of our (contractual) relationship, we can also share your personal data with some of our partners (e.g. AWS, Navis, Alfapass, security company, etc.). We will ensure that these recipients undertake to process your personal data in compliance with the applicable legislation. If these recipients process your personal data outside the European Economic Area we will use our best efforts to conclude the necessary (contractual) safeguards in this regard (e.g. EC Standard Clauses or similar contractual safeguards) in order for your personal data to have an adequate level of protection.

When legally justified or required, your personal data may also be transferred to competent governments and/or other law enforcement authorities (e.g. police, investigating judge, data protection authority, Nxtport, etc.)

You are at all times entitled to access your personal data and have them corrected when inaccurate or incomplete, to have them erased and to have the processing thereof restricted, when the legal conditions hereto are met. In as far as the processing is based on your consent, you may withdraw your consent at all times.

Please note however that we, and as the case may be, other companies of the DP World group and/or our partners, may not be able to comply with our/their contractual obligations in such case. We do not accept any liability in this regard.

You have the right to request a copy of your personal data as well as the right to data portability and the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

We will retain your personal data as long as necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected or longer, if required by law.
