- o Lay-Can and Lay-time.
- \circ ETA Vessel with 5-3-2-1 days, Any time ETA changes by more than 12 hours must be submitted to Sokhna Port maximum by 11:00 LT in working days. (For cement vessel's 48 hours required).
- o Full Ship particular for the expected vessel. And Ex-Name if any.
- o Last two ports including last port of loading and if loaded any transit cargo.
- o Next port after Sokhna Port.
- Communication channel of Ship Agent e-mail address fax and PIC phone AOH and Mobile if any, Shipper and Surveyor such as telephone number and facsimile number.
- o Cargo plan.
- Copy of B\L and Manifest
- Existing loading holes with dia & position on each hatch cover for vessels loading bulk cement.
- For vessels loading bulk cement, delivery rate should not be less than 6000 M/T per day.
- For vessels loading bulk cement, loading means should be provided from the shipper prior vessel arrival.
- For vessels to load cargo via ship loader [conveyor belt] the free board shouldn't be more than 9 mtrs.
- o Any hazardous cargo onboard IMO Class based on IMDG.



- o Any required supplies as Fuel Lub Oil, garbage disposal or fresh water.
- o Any maintenance required during vessel's stay side painting or welding.
- o Any fire drill or emergency training or boat lowering at the port.
