

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CEO's MESSAGE

As Pakistan continues to face multiple issues resulted from economic crisis, depleting foreign currency reserves and the added pressure on economy due to flood, it is indeed a tough time for the businesses, hence QICT has also seen a plunge in the volumes compared to the same period in 2021. However, we should not let this stray us away from our prime focus, that is, providing timely services to our clients and customers.

On a positive note, we had the honor to welcome DP World's Group Chairman and CEO, Mr. Sultan Ahmed Bin Sulayem for his visit in Pakistan. He stopped by our terminal and then visited the flood-affected communities. He met the affected individuals and donated a generous amount from DP World Foundation.



It was a proud moment for all of us, when QICT was recognized by CPPI as Pakistan's best performing container port, 81st out of 370 terminals worldwide.

In terms of capacity building, it is a significant step forward for QICT to have received 9 new RTGs from ZPMC China in the month of August. This would go a long way in helping us achieve our higher levels of performance.

I would also like to applaud the entire Operations and Engineering team for sustaining a GMPH of over 21 for this quarter. I would also like to commend the entire Operations and Gates team for maintaining the Truck turnaround time around the 100 minutes' mark. Well done!

This quarter was filled with celebrations! On the occasion of QICT's 25th anniversary, all permanent employees received a cash reward of 100,000/- as a token of appreciation. It is truly heartening to see how far we've come since we moved our first vessel on August 10th, 1997.

With respect to safety, we have witnessed a drastic reduction in incident occurrences which reflects improvement in our QHSE management system, hence upholding our prime goal of ZERO harm through Senior Management Interactions, High Risk Activities, Workplace HSE Inspections, Hazard Reporting, Internal Audits, HSE Assessment compliance, action management etc., all of which are recorded in the GHSE App under respective modules.

In an effort to uphold global goals, we have established prohibition of single use plastic policy and going forward more initiatives will be undertaken to ensure that the workplace as well as the environment as a whole is not adversely affected by our processes / activities.

We have successfully completed another safe quarter and move into the last phase of the year 2022. I am looking forward to more and more initiatives around the terminal to continuously improve our processes that bring efficiency, enable our people and ensure the high levels of Safety standards that we live by. ZPMC New 9XRTGs Offloading / Crane Transformation & Comissioning




DP World-Karachi received 9 new RTGs from ZPMC China, equipped with Cummins X15 engines and Siemens Sinamic drives system. Offloading & crane transformation of these cranes was completed by the experts of team ZPMC whereas commissioning is in progress.

> New Features and Its Benefits

- New Auto Gantry Steering System (AGSS) system due to which the operator no longer needs to pay much attention to which way RTG is heading.
- Truck Positioning System (TPC) will prevent spreader's load crashing on truck cabin when truck is not fully aligned.
- Position Determination System (PDS) will increase the accuracy of stacking as a result of which terminal operation productivity will be enhanced.

Addition of these brand new cranes will improve the overall reliability, productivity & availability of terminal's equipment.





Dp World Donates \$2.5 Million And Pledges Logistics Support For Pakistan Flood Relief



DP World Chairman and CEO Sultan Ahmed Bin Sulayem visited Pakistan where he pledged logistics support and donated \$2.5 million to help people in the south of the country following the recent devastating floods.

DP World donates \$2.5 million

After visiting flood-affected areas, the Chairman met with Pakistan's President Arif Alvi and Chief of Army Staff General Qamar Javed Bajwa. DP World donated \$1 million to the Pakistan Army Fund for Flood Affectees and pledged another \$1.5 million in relief items, including shelter, medication, food items, and cooking implements.

The donations are through the DP World Foundation, which was launched in April to carry out humanitarian work and facilitate initiatives financed by the public and private sectors.



The extra protection (padding) inside the TYPE II helmet along with impact penetration attenuation and off-center penetration ensures the penetrator does not affect the head form.


Stress has been reported and associated with health conditions such as; anxiety, muscle pain, high blood pressure, weakened Immune system, heart disease, depression, obesity.

Cash Reward for 25th Anniversary of QICT


Cash Reward of 100,000/- was disbursed to all permanent staff on the occasion of 25th anniversary of $\mbox{QICT}.$

Asia Cup Final Screening




I. Imagine A Greener Future Event - Get Everyone Involved in The World's to Do List (SDG17)


Flood Affected Support








SUCCESS STORY






