

SAFETY AND SECURITY INFORMATION FOR VISITORS

DP WORLD SOUTHAMPTON SECURITY

- You will be issued with a DP World Southampton security pass—please keep this with you
 and display at all times when on our site. Your security pass is required for access into the
 terminal's restricted area.
- You may be liable for personal and/or vehicle search whilst on site.
- Please be aware that 24 hour CCTV recording is in operation on our site.
- Smoking on site is only permitted in designated locations ask your site host where these
 are if you require them.

DRIVING IN AND AROUND DP WORLD SOUTHAMPTON

- The speed limit on the main dock road is 30 mph.
- Within the DP World Southampton security fence line the speed limit is 20 mph.
- The speed limit in the car park is 10 mph.
- Wearing of seat-belts is mandatory.
- Use of hand held mobile phones whilst driving is prohibited.
- You are not permitted to drive on your own on the quay unless trained to do so.
- If you require vehicle access to this area, Security should be requested to escort you.

DP WORLD SOUTHAMPTON OPERATIONAL AND ENGINEERING AREAS

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be worn at all times when out on site anywhere within the
 Security fence line and 204 workshop building basic PPE requirement includes helmet, hi-viz and safety footwear.
- A limited stock of safety helmets and hi-viz can be borrowed from Security if required.
- Follow all instructions given to you by your site host or other DP World Southampton representative.
- Watch out for any moving vehicles. Drivers may have restricted visibility; you may be stood in a blind spot.
- Only use a mobile phone if you are in a safe location away from the work activity and any machinery movements.
- Report any accidents, incidents, near misses or dangerous occurrences as soon as possible to your site host or any DP World Southampton manager.

FIRE

- If you discover a fire in a building while on site, please activate the fire alarm system by breaking the glass on any fire alarm call point.
- If in a building, leave in the company of your site host, who will escort you to the designated fire assembly point.
- Only take belongings that are available to hand do not return for anything else.
- All security doors, gates and turnstiles will 'free wheel' when the fire alarm sounds there is no need to use a security pass to exit.
- If you discover a fire when elsewhere on site, raise the alarm by calling the shift manager. Also let your site host know.

FIRST AID

- If you require any first aid during your visit, please inform your site host or contact Security either at reception or 207 Security Lodge.
- Security also have an Emergency Response Vehicle (ERV) which can be called to your location if you
 are incapacitated.
- Let your site host know if you have received any first aid treatment.
- Please report all personal injury accidents on site in one of our accident books these can be found at Reception and 207 Security Lodge.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

If you call the emergency services yourself, please also let the shift manager know without delay – we will then implement our emergency response procedures to ensure that the emergency services are escorted to the required location.

ON LEAVING DP WORLD SOUTHAMPTON

- Advise your site host when you are leaving.
- Return any temporary security passes to Security Reception or 207 Security Lodge, together with any Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) you have borrowed.
