Customer Advisory – DP World Southampton

Energy Adjustment Mechanism (EAM) 2023

At the start of October we announced the Energy Adjustment Mechanism (EAM) fee to apply at DP World Southampton in 2023. We committed to review the EAM in December to adjust for any favourable impact in our energy input prices from the UK Government Energy Bill Relief Scheme prior to 1st January 2023 applicability.

Having completed this review, we will maintain the 2023 EAM at the levels previously advised:

- **The 2023 EAM fee remains at £16.88 per import laden container**
- **The EAM fee will be made to the clearing agent who makes the customs declaration**
- **The clearing agent will be credited 75p per EAM fee paid to cover the administrative costs associated with the transaction**
- **The revised 2024 EAM will be advised by 30SEP23 to provide sufficient notice & visibility to supply chain partners**
