The role

This includes Quay Cranes, such as Ship-to-Shore Cranes and Mobile Harbor Cranes, as well as Main Yard Equipment like Rubber-Tyred Gantry Cranes and Rail-Mounted Gantry Cranes.

The Crane Maintenance Supervisor ensures that all equipment remains in optimal functional and operational condition, in alignment with the terminal's operational requirements, the Engineering Department's maintenance strategy, and the lifecycle plans of the assets. The role also requires strict adherence to the minimum technical and safety standards set by the Original Equipment Manufacturers, as well as compliance with DP World's global engineering and health, safety, security, and environmental standards.

This position plays a critical role in maintaining equipment reliability and availability, supporting the terminal's operational efficiency, and upholding the safety and quality standards of DP World Paramaribo.
