



Empowering Women in Crisis: A Year of Shelter and Support

Stichting Tehuis voor Vrouwen in Crisissituaties (Sticris) sought sponsorship for a room to support women in crisis for one year. The initiative garnered \$1,500 in donations, symbolizing a community's commitment.

On May 3, 2023 this donation was extended to the management of the women's shelter. Each room sponsorship impacts a family of 4, offering sanctuary and support to those in need.



Uniting for a Cleaner Suriname: SuReSur's Call for Support

On September 1, 2022, the Stichting Support Recycling Suriname (SuReSur) Foundation appealed for support for World Clean Up Day on September 17. They sought SRD 10,000 to bolster their efforts in promoting recycling and environmental sustainability. With this funding, SuReSur aimed to mobilize communities, clean up waste, and raise awareness about the importance of preserving Suriname's natural beauty for future generations.

During the GO Green Week, DP World
Paramaribo participated in the annual "World
Clean Up Day" activity on September 15. Led by
the SuReSur foundation in Suriname,
DP World Paramaribo, along with 17 employees
and family members, cleaned up near their own
port in La Vigilantia, Para, filling over 55 garbage
bags of litter.



Monthly Aid: Ensuring Paramaribo Zoo's Operation

Throughout the entirety of 2023, the Paramaribo Zoo sought monthly support totaling SRD 10,000 to ensure the maintenance and operation of the zoo. This ongoing assistance aimed to provide essential care for the animals, maintain facilities, and sustain educational programs for visitors. By contributing to the zoo's upkeep, donors played a vital role in preserving biodiversity and fostering appreciation for wildlife in Suriname.



Improving Patient Care

On August 17, 2023, the Stichting Nationale Bloedbank of the Surinamese Red Cross proposed a collaboration with CMA CGM and other maritime stakeholders to acquire a plasma freezer.

DP World Paramaribo contributed with a donation amounting to \$2500, aimed to enhance blood storage capabilities, ensuring the availability of life-saving plasma for patients in need.

This strategic partnership between the blood bank and maritime entities showcased a collective commitment to healthcare infrastructure and the wellbeing of Suriname's population.



Supporting Women's Workshop

On March 8, 2023, International Women's Day, Het EFS College COVAB reached out for financial assistance to provide meals for a workshop focused on empowering women to reassess their selfperception and seize opportunities for personal growth. The request, totaling SRD 14,800, aimed to enable women to embrace their potential and enhance their lives significantly. This donation demonstrated a firm commitment to women's empowerment, celebrating their resilience and achievements on their dedicated day.




Cultivating Green Skills: Impactful Projects Under Our World, Our Future
