- Knowledgeable of Occupational Health & Safety requirements.
- Experienced in Maintenance management software.
- Exceptional inter-personal skills.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills in Dutch and English.
- Well-developed analytical and problem-solving skills.
- Good time management skills (ability to focus & prioritise to meet deadlines)

Main activities

- Carry responsibility as the Project Lead for equipment improvement projects.
