YARD SUPERVISOR

Our Yard Supervisor is responsible for the coordination of all yard activities.

- Supervises loading/offloading of containers.
- Ensures that the operations are run safely and clearly instructs team of Stevedores, Crane Operators and vessel crew.
- Ensures that any CCU's received at the yard to be loaded on board of the vessels are compliant with HSE requirements.

The Yard Supervisor has:

- At least 1-3 years experience within the Oil & Gas/Marine Industry or associated fields.
- Strong organisational skills.
- Good interpersonal skills with ability to build working relations.
- Good communication skills & good knowledge of written and Spoken Dutch & English.

RIGGER

Rigger is the skilled person who safely utilizes all lifting gear during the operations.

Mainly the Rigger:

- Maintains all rigging equipment such as shackles, tirsors, winches, to ensure safety.
- Works safely with cranes and lifting operations.
- Ensures containers and lifting gears are approved for use and conduct visual inspection prior to use.
- Use of rigging techniques for handling material, heavy equipment and pipes.

- A proficient level in spoken and written Dutch and English.
- A valid Rigger Job license
- A Mechanical diploma
- OPITO Rigger Certificate (stage 2)
- At least 2 years of experience as a Rigger.

MECHANIC

Our Mechanic Is responsible for performing preventive, troubleshooting and corrective maintenance activities independently on all mobile equipment, vehicles and facilities equipment related to the operations of the Business Unit, in support of the operations.

Mainly the Mechanic:

- Performs inspections of mobile equipment, vehicles and facilities or equipment, independently in accordance with the manufacturer recommendations and internal procedures.
- Performs scheduled maintenance of mobile heavy equipment, light vehicles and facilities equipment independently.
- Performs and completes root cause analysis on mobile heavy equipment, light vehicles and facilities equipment and associated parts/ components, independently. - Maintains a clean and orderly workplace during and after repairs/ maintenance activities. Applies the 6S methodology at all work areas.



The Mechanic has:

- A completed secondary mechanical or electrical Engineering education or equivalent.
- Knowledge of preventive & corrective maintenance best practices and concepts.
- Minimum 2 years of work experience in an apprenticeship position.
- A safety, continuous improvement and learning mindset

Completed safety training on:

- Working at Heights
- Low and High voltage
- Hand and Power tools (including measuring tools).
- A valid driver's license, category BE.
- A proficient level in spoken and written Dutch and English.
- A team player mindset.
